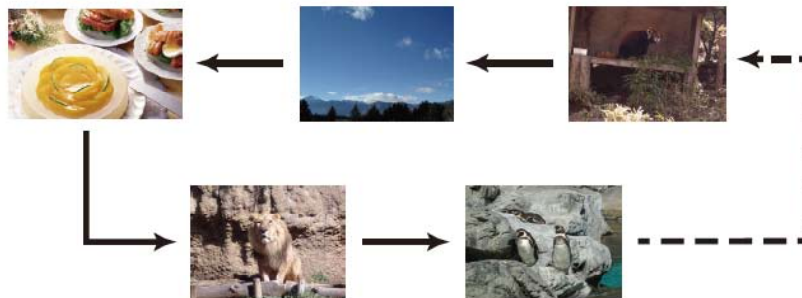


1. PC-Less Presentations

Tired of traveling with your laptop? Do you want a fail safe back up for your important presentation. By saving your Power Point to a JPEG file on your USB flash drive you are able to carry your entire presentation inside your pocket. If your computer fails during the presentation than you can plug the flash drive right in to the computer and resume your presentation. When you insert a USB flash drive or a USB storage device into the projector, you will see thumbnail images of the presentation.



Or you can select an individual slide or slide show and your presentation will run automatically.



2. Connect the USB Directly to the Computer

Now you can quickly hook your projector directly to your computer using the USB port. Eliminate the need for a VGA cable when the computer and projector are in close proximity (USB cable is limited to about 15 feet). LiveViewer software in the computer will run automatically when you hook up the projector via USB. Right click on the LiveViewer icon in the lower left hand corner, then click display and then play. A quick and simple way to view you spread sheets or Power Point presentations.
